- Very strong and attractive woman
- Described by Dion Wright as "a visionary American mystical Christian" from the Wichita Vortex tempered in San Francisco and brought to fruition in New York – her works are inspirational, poetical and original – a luminary..."
- Was interested and involved in the emancipation of women
- 1959-1962 San Francisco pursued writing career and strongly influenced by the attitudes and techniques of artists who were her friends.
